Day 159 | Tuesday | August 11 | [2 Corinthians 10](#)

Paul defends his ministry; Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord.

Day 160 | Wednesday | August 12 | [2 Corinthians 11](#)

Paul: Watch for false prophets, I have suffered many things for Christ, If I must boast, I will boast of the things that show my weakness.

Day 161 | Thursday | August 13 | [2 Corinthians 12](#)

Paul: I saw a revelation where I was caught up into the 3rd heaven; thorn in the flesh to keep me humble; Therefore I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities for the sake of Christ; for whenever I am weak, then I am strong (vs 10); Paul is concerned what he will find in the Corinth church if he comes and concerned with their behavior and how it effects the life in Jesus Christ.

Day 162 | Friday | August 14 | [2 Corinthians 13](#)

Paul: Examine yourselves to see whether you are living in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not realize that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless, indeed, you fail to pass the test! The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

Prayer:

Pray for the redemption of the World. Pray for those persecuted for the faith today. Pray for your personal discipleship and your calling to serve the Kingdom of God in your world.
