Readings:

Day 103 | Monday | May 25 | Acts 14 | Paul and Barnabas methodology for missionary work was to show up in a synagogue, proclaim the gospel, divide the people there, they get mad, thrown into jail or escape out of town to do the same in the next village; they streak in Lystra and Derby to prove they are mortals; journey through area brings them back to their base in Antioch where they report of the wonders and miracles and converts to the Way.

Day 104 | Tuesday | May 26 | Acts 15 | This chapter deals with the theological question of whether Gentiles (non-Jewish) Christians have to follow Jewish practices and purity laws in order to be a "real" Christian; Barnabas and Paul testified to all the miracles and wonders that happened during their missionary journey; the church leaders set no restrictions except some dietary matters and fornication; the news was rec'd with joy by the Antioch community; Paul and Barnabas part ways and head off on different journeys to proclaim the Gospel.

Day 105 | Wednesday | May 27 | Acts 16 | Timothy joins Paul and Silas; Paul's vision of Macedonian; Lydia is redeemed; note change of language from third person to second person; Paul and Silas in prison and more redeemed.

Day 106 | Thursday | May 28 | Acts 17 | Paul and Silas go to Thesselonica - Jews create a riot - got other Christians who were arrested, posted bail, and were freed; That very night the believers $[\underline{f}]$ sent Paul and Silas off to Beroea - went to a synagogue- they were more receptive - Silas and Timothy stayed; Paul goes and preaches in Athens;

Day 107 | Friday | May 29 | Acts 18 | Paul stays in Corinth and sets up a business with a friend to support himself; preaches to Jewish people and gives up and preaches to the rest of the people and the body of believers grew in faith and wisdom; Paul is brought before the procounsel and is dismissed from any wrong doing; Jews get mad and beat up someone; Paul with friends go back to Antioch; description of Apollos' ministry.
