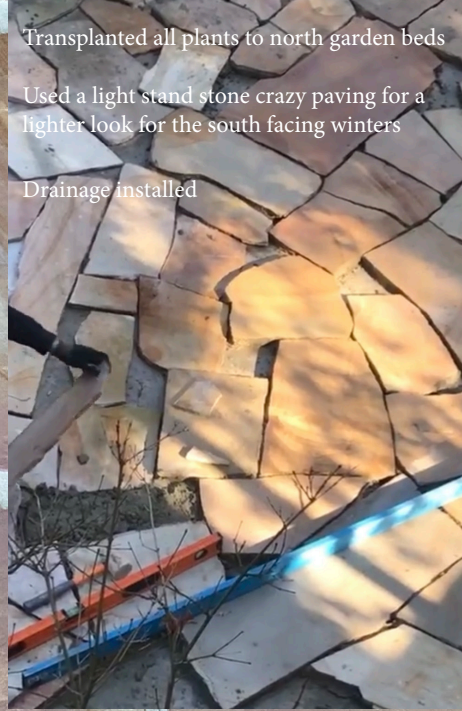




Notes:

Transplanted all plants to north garden beds

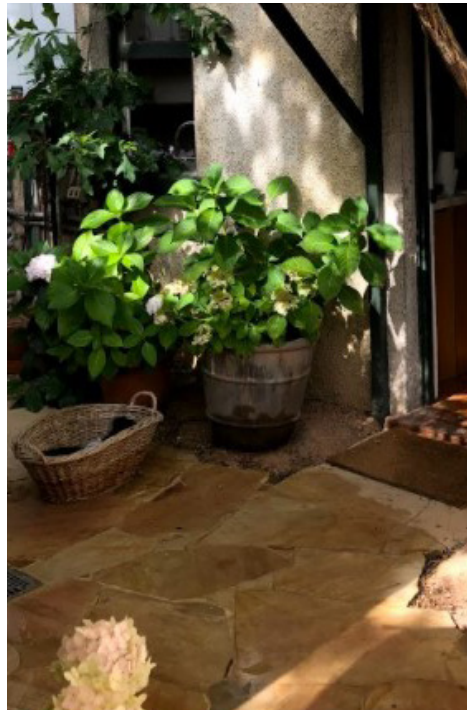
Used a light sand stone crazy paving for a lighter look for the south facing winters

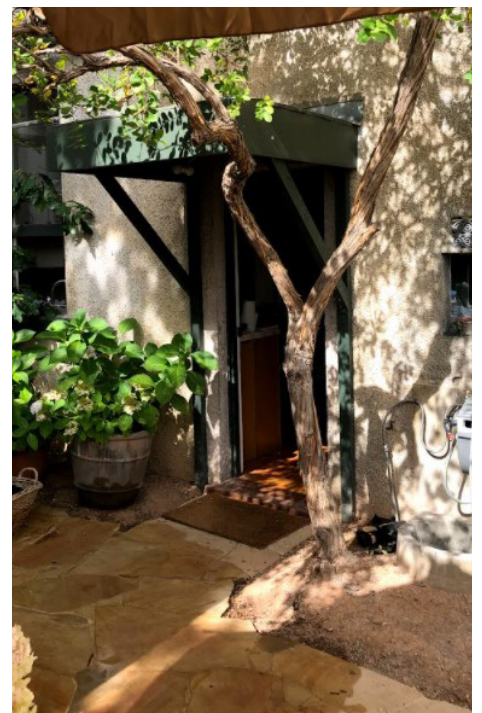
Drainage installed
