Day 88 | Monday | May 4 | John 20 | The stone is rolled away, Mary runs to Peter, Peter and the other disciple run to the tomb, they found no Jesus, Jesus, "Woman why do you weep?; They have taken away my Lord; Mary he says; Teacher she says; I have not yet ascended; Jesus shows up to locked and fearful disciples sans Thomas; Thomas sees Jesus a week later; Many other things happens but these are recorded that you might believe and have life in his name.

Day 89 | Tuesday | May 5 | John 21 | Jesus serves breakfast as Simon and the boys have gone back to their lives; they catch 153 fish without tearing their nets; they recognize Jesus; Peter – tend my lambs, tend my sheep, feed my sheep; the library would be vast to write everything that Jesus did (and it is.)

Day 90 |Wednesday | May 6 | <u>Acts 1</u> | The writer of Luke recalls to his/her patron the telling the story of Jesus and now the founding of the Church of the Way; Jesus – not just Israel but the whole world and ascends to heaven; angels ask what are you looking at?; They gather in prayer including women; they appoint by lot to complete the 12 apostles.

Day 91 | Thursday | May 7 | <u>Acts 2</u> | Day of Pentecost when the disciple receive the Holy Spirit; Peter speaks – fulfills prophet Joel – what King David says of him; what should we do? repent and be baptized; awe came upon all of the people because of the signs and wonders done by the apostles; they gathered in the Temple praising God and being happy; their numbers increased.

Day 92 | Friday | May 8 | <u>Acts 3</u> | Peter heals, speaking in Solomon's portico, vs 26 – When God raised up his servant (Jesus), he sent him first to you, to bless you by turning each of you from your wicked ways.
